

# United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP)

UNDRIP is a declaration that protects the rights of Indigenous Peoples around the world. UNDRIP has been endorsed and supported by member states of the United Nations including Malaysia on 13 September 2007.

Among the key rights under UNDRIP are:



**Right to nationality**



**Right to access to social and health services**



**Right to education at all levels**



**Right to be free from any form of discrimination**



**Right to lands, territories and natural resources**



**Right to practise cultural traditions and customs**



**Right to life, freedom and security**



**Right to free, prior and informed consent (FPIC)**
